Suggested Registry Items...

DINING ROOM

Tableware

Tip: Choose a pattern and register for 8 to 12 place settings. (You can always add later).

Formal patterns have five pieces (entertaining)

**** You may not have room to store these items at this point in your life, but this is something that should be registered for if you don't want to pay personally for this big ticket item later on****

Dinner plate
Salad/dessert plate
Bread-and-butter plate
Cup
Saucer

Additional pieces to consider:

9-inch accent plate
Rim soup bowl
Soup/cereal bowl
Medium-size platter
Vegetable bowl
Gravy boat
Sugar bowl and creamer

A more casual pattern will have four pieces (every day use)

Dinner plate
Salad/dessert plate
Soup/cereal bowl
Mug

Flatware

Tip: Register for flatware based on the number of tableware settings you've selected.

Each flatware setting includes:

Dinner fork
Dinner knife
Soup spoon
Salad/dessert fork

Additional flatware to consider:

Salad server
Cake serve
Gravy ladle
Steak knives

Tip: Stick with neutral colors that will mesh with any decor for years to come.

2 tablecloths
8 to 12 placemats
8 to 12 napkins
8 to 12 napkin rings

Appliances and Accessories

Tip: Don't just register for a gadget that looks cool; choose ones that you'll actually use!

Spatulas
Wooden spoons
Whisk
Cheese grater
Instant-read meat thermometer
Oven mitts

Glass or plastic containers for leftovers
Measuring cups and spoons
Dish towels
Salad spinner
Rice cooker

Glassware

Tip: Register for the same number of glasses as place settings, plus a few more for parties or to replace broken pieces. You can also register for two sets of glassware—formal and casual.

Goblets
Iced-beverage glasses
All-purpose wineglasses
Champagne flutes
Double-old-fashioned glasses
Martini glasses
Martini pitchers
Iced tea pitcher
Margarita glasses
Margarita pitcher

BEDROOM

Tip: Some guests will want to spend more than the traditional \$100 on your gift. So be sure to include some bigger-ticket items, such as a bed frame or dresser.

Linens

Two sets of sheets (one for your bed, one for a guest bed); include flat and fitted sheets
Two sets of pillowcases
Comforter or duvet
Bed skirt
Pillows
Accent pillows
Blankets
Mattress cover

Tip: Register for one set of special towels to be used for company only.

Linens

Tip: Choose neutral, matching accessories; watch out for metals that can tarnish or rust.

- Toilet cover
